

Appendix A Residential Curbside Pickup Services

Items that may be placed curbside for bulk pickup include yard debris, tree limbs and normal household junk or rubbish. Customer shall follow these guidelines when placing items curbside.

1. **Fees.** Fees for this service shall be published in the City of Sallisaw Master Fee Schedule. When a customer schedules a pickup and is serviced, the City will add the service fee to their next utility billing statement.
2. This service shall be provided by an **OVERHEAD LIFTING DEVICE**. **Debris must be stacked on your property, in an area that can be serviced by the lifting device. Do not place piles under utility lines or low hanging tree limbs.**
3. **Junk, rubbish, biodegradable wood waste and metal shall not be mixed together.** These items shall be separated into separate piles allowing the equipment operator to separate all metal.
4. **Do not** place debris around any obstacles such as mailboxes, phone boxes, cable boxes, trees, fire hydrants, water meter boxes, etc. Items **will not be collected if any of these obstacles interfere with the lifting device.** Customer will be responsible for moving the waste to another area of their property.
5. Debris must be placed curbside for pick up by homeowner no more than 72 hours before the scheduled pickup day. It is suggested the homeowner schedule the pick-up services as soon as the debris is curbside.
6. **Pick up service has a minimum charge based on 10 cubic yards per pickup.** This volume is based on approximate measurements of 10 feet long x 5 feet wide and stacked no more than 5 feet high. Volumes exceeding this amount may be assessed additional charges.
7. **All grass clippings, small trimmings and leaves** must be bagged for service in heavy duty trash bags that are not subject to ripping. Materials blown or raked out to edge of street or in the street will be subject to Code Enforcement fines.
8. **Tree limbs shall be trimmed to no longer than ten (10) feet in length.** Brush shall be trimmed as much as possible. Other material or debris should not exceed 10 feet in length.
9. Pickup of “White Goods”. White goods are allowed to be placed curbside. Any white good having a compressor with Freon, must have the compressor removed before pickup.
10. **Certain material or items will not be picked up, such as:**
 - Appliances utilizing Freon, unless the compressor has been removed.
 - No hazardous waste or free flowing liquids. No batteries, paint, oil, cooking oil, fuel, chemicals, pesticides, fertilizers, cleaning products, pharmaceuticals, etc.
 - Dirt and rocks (Single large rocks may be picked up subject to size and weight).
 - Butane or propane tanks.
 - Roofing materials, tires or other heavy rubber materials.
 - Items of excessive weight exceeding the maximum operating weight of the lifting device.
